Co-Chair of Working Group II for the 7th cycle of IPCC

An expert in weather and climate information, he is currently the Scientific Director at Deltares, Delft, Netherlands. He previously spent 23 years at the Dutch Meteorological Institute, working on climate change scenarios, land-atmosphere interaction, and leading a weather and climate modeling research team. He is also a Professor at VU University Amsterdam, focusing on climate and socio-ecological system interaction. As a Lead Author of the Sixth Assessment Report, he coordinated European research projects on soil moisture data assimilation, climate services for the water sector, and global climate impacts on Europe. He has joined international expert teams on land-atmosphere interaction, climate change communication, compound event analysis, and forecast-based financing for disaster relief in developing countries.

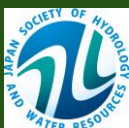
